

As a valued guest we wanted to provide an update on our latest efforts to prevent the spread and potential impact of the Coronavirus (COVID-19).

In consideration of recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and requests from both federal and state governments, the Pokagon Gaming Authority has decided to close all of its Four Winds Casinos locations in Michigan and Indiana beginning at 3 a.m. Eastern on Tuesday, March 17. The timeframe of the closure is until March 30th pending reevaluation at the end of the closure period.

As we noted previously, all scheduled entertainment through April 4 is being postponed and will be rescheduled. Ticket refunds are being offered at the point-of-sale.

Current hotel and restaurant reservations which were booked for dates during the closure will be cancelled without penalty.

Also all scheduled promotions have been cancelled.

We thank you for your patience and understanding as we work to navigate this evolving situation.
