Volunteer Opportunities for the 2019 Four Winds Invitational

Over 200 volunteers needed for Tournament on June 7–9

SOUTH BEND, Indiana (April 5, 2019) – The Pokagon Band of Potawatomi Indians and Four Winds® Casinos announced today they are seeking approximately 220 volunteers for the 2019 Four Winds Invitational. Volunteers are needed for morning, afternoon and evening shifts for all three days of the tournament, which begins Friday, June 7 through Sunday, June 9 at Blackthorn Golf Club in South Bend. The Four Winds Invitational is part of the Symetra® Tour – Road to the LPGA®.

Volunteers are needed to fill the following roles: caddies, cart and shuttle drivers, driving range assistants, food and beverage servers, marshals, spotters, scorers, and standard bearers.

All selected volunteers must be at least 16 years of age prior to June 1. They are required to pay a \$25 fee by June 1, and will receive a tournament polo shirt, hat and one round of golf at Blackthorn Golf Club. Food and beverages will also be provided to volunteers on each day of service. Volunteers must attend a training session and complete nine total hours of service before receiving their free round of golf.

Since Symetra's inaugural sponsorship year in 2012, the Symetra Tour has grown from 16 tournaments and \$1.7 million in prize money to \$4.0 million in prize money awarded over the course of 24 tournaments. With more than 600 alumnae moving on to the LPGA, former Symetra Tour players have won a total of 437 LPGA titles.

The Pokagon Band of Potawatomi Indians' sovereignty was reaffirmed under legislation signed into law by President Clinton in September of 1994. The Pokagon Band's ten-county service area includes four counties in Southwestern Michigan and six in Northern Indiana.
